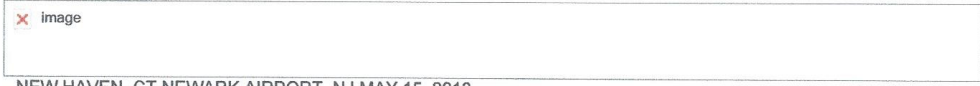

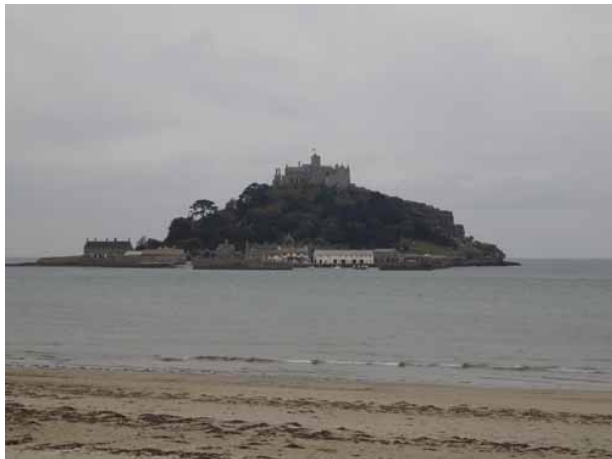

THE LAND'S END
RESTAURANT

Introduction

Land's End is a name that has struck at people's imagination for thousands of years, with the Romans referring to it as 'Bolerium', the seat of storms, and the old Cornish name being 'Penn-an-Wlas, end of the land.

People have been visiting Land's End for generations, in the early nineteenth century they would travel to the First and Last Inn before making the final stage of the journey on horseback or foot along the narrow lanes. At this time the only building here was a small animal shelter where the horses would be tethered whilst visitors walked around the site.



The original Longships Lighthouse was built in 1795 but was considered too small, a larger one was built in the 1870s and is now 71 feet tall. Originally the lighthouse was manned by three men on a shift basis, communication to them was made from outside the hotel and was sent by apparatus called Semaphore, a photograph of this can be seen in the hotel bar. The lighthouse is now operated automatically.

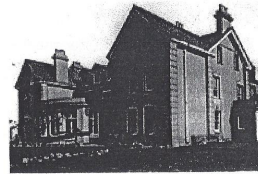
The first proper buildings are believed to have been built around the middle of the nineteenth century when the animal shelter was turned into a small hotel, this building has since been developed further to become the existing hotel.



In 1859 the Great Western Railway brought passenger trains into Penzance carrying a new crowd of wealthy tourists. At this point Penwith House was built just alongside the main hotel and was opened as a Temperance Hotel.



The actual Land's End point is situated in front of the First and Last House which is believed to have opened shortly after Penwith House. A lady called Gracie Thomas ran the First and Last House, she sold refreshments and basic souvenirs such as lumps of granite. This was also the first time that you could purchase a postcard with Land's End stamped on it, a tradition that is kept today.



The Land's End Hotel has itself had a chequered history. At the turn of the 20th century the hotel was a place of true Victorian splendour, proudly run by Benjamin Trahair who was known to always wear a white suit, some people say that he still roams around the top corridor to this day. During the Second World War the hotel started to suffer; a Luftwaffe bomb severely damaged a large proportion of the original building in 1941 and killed one man who was drinking in the bar. After this American servicemen were stationed there before being sent to the D-Day Landings. During this period the hotel was treated pretty badly and it was some time before it was repaired. At one stage the building was used as a store on the first floor.

The famous Land's End Signpost has been operated independently since the 1950s. The existing company (Coutwoods Ltd) used to own a post situated in front of the hotel, whilst another local photography company operated a post near to its present location. In the early 1960s Coutwoods took ownership of both and still send photographs all around the world.

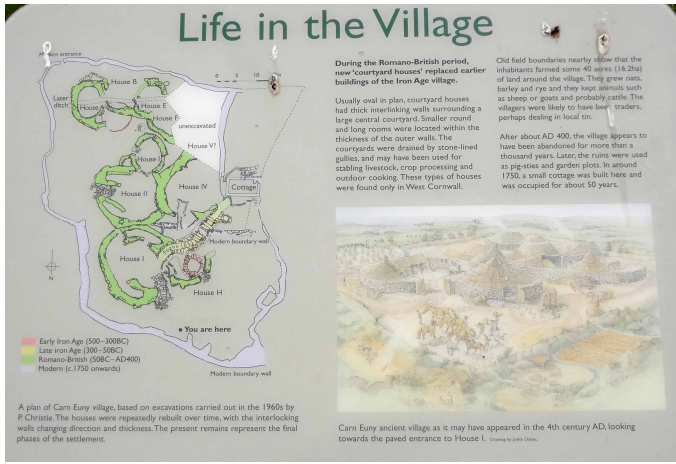
In 1954 Francis St Aubyn, the 3rd Lord St Levan, gave St Michael's Mount and a large endowment fund to the National Trust, retaining a 999-year lease for the family to live in the castle. While the National Trust now ensures the preservation and conservation of the Mount, the St Aubyn family continue to live on and manage the island today as they have done since the 17th century.

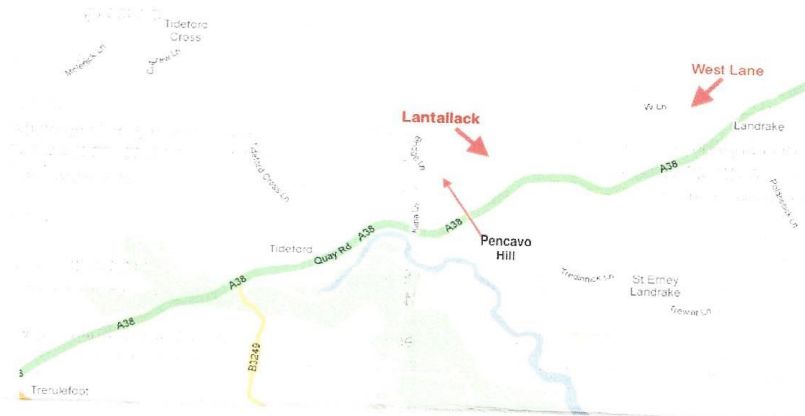
Directions to Lantallack for Guests and Bridal Party

From Plymouth & Saltash: Follow the A38 towards Liskeard, and at Landrake go under the footbridge and take the second turning right into West Lane, and follow this road for ¼ mile. At the white cottage on your right, and Hay Lake Farm on your left, go straight on and turn immediately left, signposted 'Tideford'. Lantallack is 200 yards on the right.

From Liskeard and West Cornwall: Follow the A38 towards Plymouth. At Landrake take the first turning left, after the speed camera, into West Lane. Continue down West Lane for ¼ mile. At the white cottage on your right, and Hay Lake Farm on your left, go straight on and turn immediately left, signposted 'Tideford'. Lantallack is 200 yards on the right.

If you do use 'sat nav' please program in 'via Landrake'. Please do not use Kilna Lane or Pencavo Hill to access Lantallack.

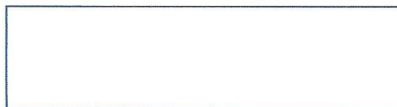
